Power Craft Plan

Day 1

7am 10Hp Sports start at Northam - Finish at Cobblers Pool

Note: Optional for 10Hp Sport competitors to choose at Registration, Friday 3rd August, to start at Katrine. 10Hp Sports choosing to start at Katrine will be ineligible for prize money, however they will compete for a short course trophy.

Start Procedure – 2 per grid, 1 minute apart

8.30am 10Hp Std, Novice and Past Racers and Formula Ten start at Katrine - Finish at Cobblers*

Start Procedure – 2 per grid, 1 minute apart following on from Sport Craft passing through Katrine. That is, start time could be slightly earlier and is at the discretion of Clerk of Course Power Craft

*Conditional Entry - Katrine to West Toodyay Bridge (Short Course)

- Craft starting at Katrine can choose at Registration to be in the conditional (short course) subcategory. No change can be made back to Cobblers Pool finish option once the decision has been made.
- All conditional entries must finish and exit the water at West Toodyay Bridge. Competitors must let timing and checkpoint crews at West Toodyay Bridge know they are conditional craft and are finishing Day 1.
- Support crew must take craft back to Cobblers Pool campsite pit area for repairs.
- More details of craft pick up to be advised at Registration.
- Should a craft register for conditional entry they are ineligible for prizes.

Cut-Off Times Day 1

When the first Paddle Craft reaches West Toodyay Bridge, all power craft upstream from there will be withdrawn from the event.

3.30pm Ti-Trees

Day 2

All craft start at Walyunga National Park

All craft to be transported from Cobblers Pool to Walyunga Sunday Morning ready for 10am start

Vehicle permits, bus passes and directions provided to all competitors at registration

Start time subject to progress of paddle craft. Clerk of Course Power to remain in contact with Rescue and Recovery crews to obtain ETA of paddle. Power Craft must all start prior to passage of paddle craft through Walyunga

Start Procedure – 1 per grid 1 minute apart

- Conditional entries will start at the back of field and are ineligible for prizes.

All relevant cut-off times remain in place for Day 2

Day 1

7.45am All Paddle Craft start in Northam – Finish at Cobblers Pool*

Start Procedure – 20 per grid, 1 minute apart

Start time could be slightly earlier and is at the discretion of Chief Clerk of Course

*Conditional Entry - Northam to West Toodyay Bridge (Short Course)

- Optional for all craft to choose at Registration, Friday 3rd August, to be in the conditional (short course) subcategory.
- All conditional entries must finish and exit the water at West Toodyay Bridge. Competitors must let timing and checkpoint crews at West Toodyay Bridge know they are conditional craft and are finishing Day 1.
- Support crew must take craft back to Cobblers Pool campsite pit area for Day 2 start.
- More details of craft pick up to be advised at Registration.
- Should a craft register for conditional entry they are ineligible for prizes.

Cut-Off Times Day 1 – please note earlier start time (7am)

11.45am Katrine

1.40pm Toodyay (Newcastle Bridge)

2.40pm West Toodyay Bridge – (conditional entry finish line)

3.30pm Ti-Trees (full course entrants only)

Day 2

All craft start at Cobblers Pool

7am Start Time

Start Procedure - 4 per grid, 1 minute apart

- Conditional entries will start at the back of field
- Clerk of Course Paddle to re-check all conditional craft scrutineer stickers
