- ◆ To raise awareness of the needs of independent scholars on such matters as copyright, public and educational lending rights, freelance rates, and the market value payment for their participation as scholars in academic activities such as thesis examination, and in advisory and assessment roles.
- ◆ To give a voice to dissent and independent opinion.
